Authoring Content to ASD S1000D Schema's

Overview:
This is a hands on workshop for authoring to v3.0 of the S1000D specification. Several modules on S1000D theory is covered to ensure understanding of the fundamentals behind the specification that the author will be working with.

Chapters 4 to 7 break out into authoring exercises. It is expected that the student will have their preferred Authoring Tool to perform these hands-on Authoring exercises. This course has been designed by ADG's S1000D trainers.

On completion of this course students will understand the fundamentals of S1000D in a project environment and will be comfortable with Authoring core components of the Descriptive and Procedural Data Modules.

Pre-requisite:

- Experience in working in a Structure Authoring environment.

- Students will require access to a computer with their preferred XML Authoring tool installed.
